- i. Failed students can register for supplementary exam from 21-04-2023 itself and need not wait for the time table.
- ii. Time table will be notified in the last week of the April.
- iii. Marks Card cum Applications (MCA) for failed candidates will not be issued from this year onwards. The Principals should collect the fee from **FAILED Candidates of MARCH 2023 Examination** if they are willing to appear for II PUC Supplementary Exam 2023 on the basis of the result sheets itself provided by the Board.
- iv. The application for II PUC Supplementary Examination 2023 from failed candidate of September-2022 Examination or prior Examinations should be accepted only on the basis of 'MCA'.
- v. Application for Rejection of results in a passed subject by a failed student of MARCH-2023 II PUC Examination should be accepted by the principals only on the basis of result sheet only and MCA will not be given this year onwards. The procedures to be followed are enumerated at the back side of 'Failed Candidate result rejection application'.
- vi. Application for Rejection of results by a student declared as PASS during II PUC 2022 Annual or Supplementary Examinations and willing to appear for II PUC 2023 Supplementary Examination should be accepted only on submission of 'ORIGINAL PASS MARKS CERTIFICATE'. For 2023 Annual Examination, a downloaded copy of web results is enough.
